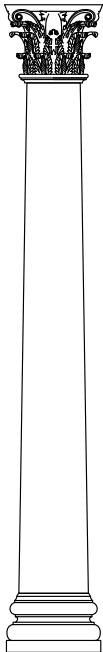




HOUSE HISTORY
